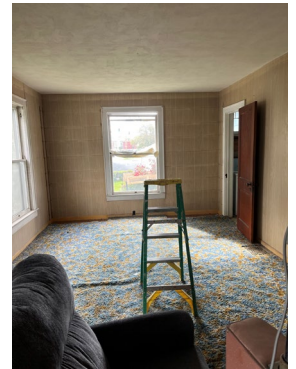

Joe's Diner hosted a give back night.

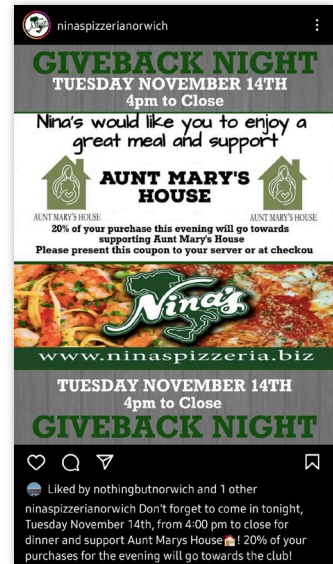
Ninas hosted a give back night.
