I am so grateful to share with you that renovations with the home are progressing well and should be complete by December. This means, if all goes well over the next couple of months, we can open Aunt Mary's House in January 2025. I know women in our community need this. Since launching this project we have supported 13 women in other ways, 10 of those women would have qualified for our program if the house had been open. Our vision is soon to become reality.

The latest home renovations include complete replacement of the roof, siding, HVAC, and electrical systems. A third bathroom was framed and all rooms have sheet rock. A pantry was framed, new windows installed, landscaping, and a security system was installed. This home has had an incredible amount of work done and we are so grateful for the quality of our contractors and the help of local volunteers.
